**6 Alterations and Amendments to Rules**

Voting was by e-ballot Opening on **WEDNESDAY 4<sup>th</sup> JANUARY at 12:00** Closing **MONDAY 23<sup>rd</sup> JANUARY at 23:59**.

Proposals have been formulated by the LMC as per Rule 1.4.3

The number of votes cast per each proposal will be announced at the virtual AGM.

Voting Rights per each club are detailed in the Appendix.

A fine of £20 will be imposed for a non-return of an online ballot.

Rule 1.9.4: At the AGM, a simple majority of more than 50% of votes cast is required to pass any alteration, amendment, correction or change of League Rules and for the election of any officer or Committee member.

**Proposals 1 - 4 TIER 1 2023 ONLY to vote (Premier & County 1) - 1 vote per team**

1	<p><b>Rule 5.1.7.1 Rewrite:</b> “Any County Division 1 club may apply for promotion to the Premier Division: such application shall be made to the League Secretary by <b>30 June</b>. The League Management Committee shall inform such clubs of their eligibility by <b>31 July</b>, and the application may not thereafter be withdrawn. Eligibility shall depend upon the fulfilment of the following criteria: Rule 7 (Ground and Facility standards), Rule 22.2 (Clubmark Accreditation), Rule 22.3 (Youth Cricket) and having a 2<sup>nd</sup> XI of an appropriate standard. <b>NEW- That 2<sup>nd</sup> XI must hold a place in Division 3 or above for the season in which their 1<sup>st</sup> XI is to play in the Premier Division. Similarly, should the 2<sup>nd</sup> XI fall below Division 3, that club’s 1<sup>st</sup> XI shall also be relegated to Division 1.”</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">LEAGUE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>FOR 12 AGAINST 10 CARRIED 54.5% IN FAVOUR</b></p>
2	<p><b>Rule 5.1.7.2 Amend to:</b> “A team must finish in first <b>or second</b> place in County Division 1 to be eligible for promotion.”</p> <p><b>Rule 5.1.7.3 Add:</b> “If the team finishing first in County Division 1 is ineligible (or has not applied for promotion), the second-placed team, if eligible, shall be promoted instead.”</p> <p><i>LMC Note: An ineligible team, or one with limited ambition, can currently block the progress of others.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">LEAGUE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>FOR 19 AGAINST 3 CARRIED 86.4% IN FAVOUR</b></p>

<p>3</p>	<p><b>Intervals – Teas</b>  <b>Rule 12.3.1</b> Add: “A traditional cricket tea shall be provided by the home club at the venue.”  <i>LMC Note: Standards (of all aspects of the game) are set higher in Tier 1. Clubs may now feel that this should include the provision of tea. If passed, Rule 14.3.1 is to be rewritten as current 12.3.1, ie. no mandatory teas for Tiers 2/3.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">CLUBS FORUM</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>FOR 12 AGAINST 10 CARRIED 54.5% IN FAVOUR</b></p>
<p>4</p>	<p><b>Over Rates</b>  <b>Rule 12.8.5</b> Replace with: “In the event of the innings time limit being reached without the scheduled number of overs having been completed, one fewer fielder shall be permitted outside the fielding circle than would normally be the case in the over in progress and any remaining overs.”                  LEAGUE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE  <i>LMC Note: Taken from ECB Generic Rules, we feel that this instant penalty is more appropriate than a points deduction.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>FOR 19 AGAINST 3 CARRIED 86.4% IN FAVOUR</b></p>

<p>6</p>	<p><b>Composition of Division 1</b>  <b>“Rule 5.1.8</b> shall be suspended for 2023 (only). From 2024 onwards, County Division 1 shall comprise <b>10 teams only</b>. The teams shall also play in a T20 Cup competition over the remaining 4 Saturdays, with a Sunday / Bank Holiday Finals Day, as currently happens in the Premier Division.                  There shall be 4 teams relegated from County Division 1 and, provided both are eligible, the Division 2 East &amp; West champions shall be promoted. If either or both are ineligible, only 3 or 2 teams shall be relegated.”  <i>LMC Notes: 1 The LMC is open-minded regarding this proposal but feels that clubs’ opinions may have changed since it was first put forward.                  2 Depending upon the result of the above, the LMC would issue a temporary version of Rule 5.1.9 for 2023 only, regarding promotion and relegation in the divisions below. <b>A</b>	<p><b>Composition of League</b> Following the merger of Premier &amp; County 1 Rules: <b>Amend</b> 4.1 The CCL shall adopt a <b>3-tier</b> structure to comprise: 4.1.1 <b>Tier 1 – Countywide.Premier (ten teams), County Division 1 (twelve teams).</b> ... and renumber.</p>
<b>B</b>	<p><b>Overseas Players Add 8.3.9 Refugees</b> 8.3.9.1 People who are defined as a refugee may play in the Cornwall Cricket League as long as full details of name, place of residence, date of birth, nationality and name and permission by signature of the case worker (on headed paper) is supplied to the Overseas Administrator. 8.3.9.2 These players will be classified as Category 3 (see rule 8.3.1) . 8.3.9.3 Players aged under 18 may be classified as Category 1. If the date of birth is not known or not verifiable, the player will be Category 3.  Also, change in Rule 8.4 the phrase ‘Tier 5 Sporting and Creative’ to ‘International Sportsperson’ Overseas Player Section 8.3 in general reworded for clarity.</p>
<b>C</b>	<p><b>Away Team Result Confirmation</b> <b>Delete</b> 11.8.2.1 and the last line of 11.8.4, as this is an unnecessary requirement.</p>
<b>D</b>	<p><b>Premier T20</b> <b>Add:</b> “13.1.8 To count back appearances for 5/8 rules and discipline procedures, a Premier T20 Match Day counts as <b>one appearance</b>, even if a player plays in both matches on the day.”</p>
<b>E</b>	<p><b>Player Eligibility</b> In all references: “The definition of a higher division player shall be a player who has played 5 of the last 8 games that have commenced for his/her registered club in the current <b>and</b> previous season.” <i>LMC Note: This clarifies in the early part of the season that the previous season is relevant and that the 75% of Premier/County 1 games transfer rule covers both seasons, at whatever stage of the current season.</i></p>
<b>F</b>	<p><b>Evening Leagues</b> <b>Add:</b> 16.2.2 “Teams may mutually agree to reschedule games up to the cut-off point. However, the League Administrator must be informed of the new date <b>NO LATER</b> than <b>SEVEN DAYS</b> before the original fixture date.” <i>(As per League Rule 11.2.1.3)</i>  16.3.2 Amend to: “Games to start no later than <b>6.15 pm</b>, except play-offs ....”</p>
<b>G</b>	<p><b>Add to all Cup Competitions</b> (Rules 17.1.4, 17.3.5 and 17.6.7): “Not applicable to Under 16 (school Year 11 or below) players, who may play unreservedly.”</p>
<b>H</b>	<p><b>Start Times</b> 17.1.8 Amend to: “All matches in the early rounds will start no later than <b>6.15 pm</b>. The Hawkey and Vinter Cup semi-finals and all evening finals will start at 6.00 pm.”</p>
<b>I</b>	<p><b>Player Eligibility</b> As per ECB National T20 Rule: “<b>Any club that fields an ineligible player shall be disqualified.</b>” This is to be added to Rules 17.1.2, 17.1.4, 17.3.2, 17.3.5 and 17.5.3 (new).</p>

<b>J</b>	<b>Add new 17.5.3</b> (and renumber): “The Edwards Cup shall be viewed as an extension of the Hawkey and Vinter Cups. No player may therefore play for two clubs in the same season.”
<b>K</b>	<b>17.6.7 Add:</b> “Any team that fields an ineligible player shall, in the group stages, forfeit the match (5 points to nil) or, in the knockout stages, be disqualified from the competition.”
<b>L</b>	<b>Administrative Penalties</b> In 36.1 h, (i) and (ii), replace “a result” and “the game”, with: “a League match”.
<b>M</b>	<b>SECTION E DISCIPLINE</b> Rules to be aligned to the new ECB’s General Conduct Regulations.

- (i) **Play-Cricket Registrations Annual Request** - To aid player communications the ECB have requested that Cornwall Cricket League members/players should individually **sign up** for membership of your club play-cricket site (top right of each homepage) and tick the box to allow communications from ECB. It also now also players to view their stats. This process is opposed to the default 'Temporary Player Membership' awarded by clubs who register players themselves. Once a member/player has entered their details, and applied for membership, they can be approved by your Club Administrator and are eligible to be given web roles on your site. They will also be able to receive the weekly Cornwall Honours Boards email from ECB. The League will annually remove registrations of players who have not played in the **last two seasons**.
