Proposals for 2025

Management Team 2025:

The Management team was considerably strengthened in 2024 with the addition of several new members including one who was co-opted onto the committee after the AGM. We do not plan any major changes for 2025 except for the addition of a Team Manager for our proposed Over 70s Championship team. A couple of positions were unfilled in 2024, namely the O50s 2nd XI Team Manager and Head of Fundraising.

Existing roles - all these are voted for at the AGM. Should there be more than one candidate for a specific role a vote will take place at the AGM. The present arrangement is that only 2024 members in attendance will be allowed to vote via a secret ballot system.

Voting for Captains:

Only those who are likely to play for an age group side in 2025 will be able to vote. For example if there was a vote for an O50s captain only those in the O60s who have played in 2024 for the O50s would be allowed to vote.

Only those 60+ will be allowed to vote for an O60s captain.

Teas 2024: How did that work given at the 2022 AGM it was agreed that the default position was not to have teas but if teams chose to provide teas then they needed to cover the full cost in addition to the match fees?

Selection Policy: We agreed a selection policy at the 2023 AGM, a copy of which is available on our website. Did this work to everyone's satisfaction?

Home Grounds 2024: Were there any issues with finding enough grounds now that we offer host grounds £100 per championship match?

County Championship Competitions 2025: The proposal is to have the same five teams as 2023 plus a new O70s 1st XI team.

Competition Changes: Discussion and subsequent voting on any known potential changes or proposals we wish to put forward to the structures, playing days and general rules of any competition we take part in. Two potential changes that we know about and plan to make representation to the appropriate National Committees are as follows:

Over $50s\ 2^{nd}\ XI$: There is a proposal to delete the option to allow two 49 yr olds in the team. The Committee view is that rather than remove this option completely, we would prefer to reduce the option to 1 x 49 yr old in 2025 with a view to removing it entirely in some future season.

Over 60s Both Competitions. The two stage group arrangement caused a huge amount of travelling and games being conceded as some teams declined to travel to Cornwall. The

Committee view is that we should revert to a single group stage followed by knock-out matches as in 2023, but delay the start of the season until the first week in May to reduce the risk of cancelled games because of the weather.
