Minutes of AGM 2022: held on October 24th 2022 - no matters arising

Member Resolutions: None Received

Any other Business: Nothing Received

Team Reports 2023:

O50s 1st XI - team reached the last 16 losing to Lancashire

O50s 2nd XI - several new players in 2023. Reached the guarter final stages.

O50s 3rd XI - first season blighted by weather - attracted several new players.

O60s 1st XI - disappointing championship season but only non first class county to play Australia

O60s 2nd XI – momentum continued and team got very close to winning a first match

O70s 1st XI – played first match v Somerset, more matches planned for 2024

Friendlies XI – fixtures were fulfilled against a variety of local and touring teams

Finance Report 2023:

Jon Nance summarised the income and expenditure for the period Oct 19th 2022 to Oct 26th 2023

Overall there was a surplus of £472

On the income side match fees were significantly up on 2022, mainly because there was an extra team and overall more matches were played.

Sponsorship was only brought in by Anton.

The handbook broke even.

The ECB provided £1000 towards the O50s 1st XI trip to the Channel Isles.

Fees and Expenses Policy for 2024

There was plenty of discussion in relation to the raising of umpire fees and whether that should be funded via an increase of $\mathfrak{L}5$ on the match fees for home matches or adding $\mathfrak{L}5$ to the membership. The latter was voted in.

All other fees remained unchanged.

Membership

£25 - up from £20 in 2023

Match Fees

£15 per home match - no change £10 per away match - no change

Players taking an umpire or scorer to an away game don't pay a match fee - no change

Umpire and Scorer Fees

Umpires £50 up from £40 per game in 2023 Scorers £40 per game - no change from 2023

Home Grounds

Home club hosts to be continued to be offered £100 per match towards the cost. The fee is for championship / knockout stage matches only, not friendly or trial matches.

Travel Policy 2024 - no change from 2023

For away games Drivers and Passengers sort out between themselves the cost of fuel with playing passengers to pay the driver a minimum of £10.

Drivers taking the umpire or scorer to away matches pay no match fee.

Players and officials travelling to the Isle of Wight for the O50s 1st XI fixture in 2024 to be supported at £50 each as per previous years.

Fundraising / Sponsorship

There was plenty of discussion around raising funds through sponsorship of matches, balls, etc...There are always lots of ideas but it needs someone to pull them together. The room was reminded that we are seeking someone to head this up. Candidates should contact the Chair.

Teas 2024:

The default position remains that we don't offer teas and if we do the cost of teas must be covered outside of the match fee.

The feeling in the room was that teas are part of cricket and are likely therefore to be part of the majority of matches.

Home Grounds 2024:

It was felt that the introduction of the ground host fee helped secure home grounds. All grounds bar one took up the offer of the £100 which continues into 2024.

O45s Hundred Tournament

County Championship Competitions 2024

We briefly discussed all competitions but only the following may result in changes to what happened in 2023:

O50s 1st XI

Group Structure - we are to vote for 8 groups of 5 teams playing each other on a home and away basis. All games including knock out matches could be on Wednesdays.

O50s 3rd XI

We will support the motion of all matches to be played on Wednesdays with a home and away group structure. It was unclear when the competition AGM will be held.

There was concern that not all players used Spond in 2023 and that as such not all teams were selected based on Spond information. Captains and Team Managers to pick this up to ensure consistency.

The key parts of the selection policy are:

'If a player chosen for a team turns down the opportunity to play for that team they will not be selected for any other team that week unless exceptional personal circumstances prevent them from playing for the selected team. They should though make that known to the selectors in advance of the teams being selected not after teams have been selected. Examples of exceptional circumstances would include work or family matters.

The 1st XIs for O50s and O60s will pick teams to include a reserve batter and a reserve bowler who will be called up if someone from the original selection has to drop out.'
