The **SIX GROUP WINNERS** and the **TWO BEST RUNNERS-UP** (average points & if equal NRR) to qualify for the quarter-finals, which will be arranged as locally as possible, provided that the runner-up will play away and no-one will meet a team from their own group.

Fixtures The first-named club shall play at home. The dates given are **final** dates and **MATCHES MUST BE PLAYED ON THESE DATES OR ANY EARLIER DATE** agreed by the competing teams. Matches may be rearranged for reasons of weather / ground conditions only. In the event of a 'No Result' on the listed final date, a match may be rearranged to take place a maximum of 10 days later (this to ensure that 2 Sundays are available).

17.6.4 Scoring of points In group matches, 5 points will be awarded for a win, 3 points for a tie, 2 points for an abandonment and 1 point for a loss. No points will be awarded for games not played, unless they are conceded or awarded as a walkover by the Competitions Committee.

17.6.4.1 In the event of two teams being equal on points, the higher position shall be awarded to the team with the higher net run rate (based on runs per over in all completed matches). Net Run Rate = (Total Runs Scored ÷ Total Overs Faced) – (Total Runs Conceded ÷ Total Overs Bowled)

Result Reporting - Home clubs **MUST** input a minimum of a play-cricket summary result **within 24 hours** of the match being played.

Matches will consist of **TWENTY OVERS** with no bowler allowed to bowl more than **FOUR** overs.

Abandoned Matches – **FIVE** overs in the second innings constitutes a match. Average run rate to apply in the event of an abandonment but the DLS method to apply in SFs & Final only.

Postponed Matches – **DO NOT** enter a result on play-cricket (e.g. Abandoned or Cancelled) as this effectively ends the match online. Simply type in the new rearranged fixture date **ONLY** and leave the rest blank

No regular Premier, County 1 or Overseas Professional player is eligible to play at any stage in the Division 2 Cup. A regular player is one played 5 of the last 8 games that have commenced for the higher team either in or outside Cornwall, in the current or previous season. Players who play for other clubs in out-of-county Saturday Leagues are not eligible to play.

Fielding Restrictions will apply in all rounds

Balls – for all matches before the semi-finals and finals, the home side must provide sound league approved cricket balls and sufficient spares of the same standard; the match ball and spares must be lodged with the umpires before the start of the match. Pink Magna balls are permitted and optional in any round of a T20 competition at the discretion of the home club. The CCL will provide new 'Pink Magna' balls for each innings for each semi-final and final. **Coloured Clothing** (not predominantly pink or red) is permitted and optional in any T20 match.

Free Hit after a No Ball

The delivery following any no ball shall be a free hit for whichever batsman is facing it. If the delivery for the free hit is not a legitimate delivery (any kind of no ball or a wide ball) then the next delivery will become a free hit for whichever batsman is facing it.
