The children themselves were full of enthusiasm and pride as they reflected on their time with Mr Cricket:

- "I loved the final Cricket World Cup game we played where you had to catch the ball. He's really fun and made all the instructions clear!"
- "Mr Cricket taught me how to hold the bat properly—then I hit some 4's and 6's in the air!"
- "We had to run in a square and I got faster each week."
- "I was enjoying learning to throw and bat the ball!"

Nick Matthews has not just delivered a sports programme; he's created lasting memories, nurtured confidence, and inspired children of all abilities. His time with us through *Chance to Shine* has had a powerful impact—not only developing skills in cricket, but fostering a love for sport, teamwork, and perseverance.
