Beginners Soft ball work. Basic batting, bowling, fielding including wicket keeping—with emphasis on learning through fun and enjoyment

Intermediate Soft to medium to hard ball work. Work on refining technique as appropriate in all aspects of the game. Skills can be analysed using images/footage on own smartphone/tablets. Emphasis on learning through analysis and feedback.

Advanced Continued work on refining your game but incorporating linking technical, tactical, physical and mental approaches. Skills can be analysed using images/footage on own smartphone/tablets. Wagon wheel analysis of strengths and emphasis on learning on how to develop all round game.

1-2-1 - will be player lead based on initial interview and information feedback from session to session and Group Coaching –up to 6 players on a agreed plan for the session led by the cricketers but managed by the Coach.
